We had an impressive number of can donations from classes before the winter break. Mr. Zach Contreras' class brought in an impressive 490 cans. However, the winning class was Mrs. Tanya Hartwig's class, which brought in 838.5 cans (462 just on the final day). In total, we brought in roughly 2,000 cans, non-perishable food items, and toiletries. Items not used for the food deliveries will stock the FCRC's pantry for our families who need help throughout the year. With the canned food and money donations, Ms. Chelsea Unger's FCRC group was able to put together 32 food deliveries for Bay families in need. Way to go Bay!

Attention all Hudson's Bay males who are 18 or about to turn 18: You must, by federal law, register with Selective Service within one month of your 18 birthday. Registering keeps you eligible for good jobs, driver's license renewal in most states, and job training. Plus, if you are an immigrant and a guy, you can never get citizenship if you don't register. You can register at the nearest US Post Office, or go on line. It only takes a few minutes and it is the LAW!
