

Earn World Language Competency Credits



The World Language Credit Program is a way to earn high school credit for a language you already know.

Step 1: Determine if you're eligible

- Can you understand ideas on familiar topics expressed through phrases, short sentences, and frequently used expressions? [Listening]
- Can you understand the main idea and some details in simple texts that contain familiar vocabulary? [Reading]
- Can you exchange information with another person about familiar tasks, topics and activities? [Person-to-Person Communication]
- Can you use a series of phrases and sentences to provide basic information about familiar topics? [Spoken Production]
- Can you write simple descriptions and short messages and request or provide information on familiar topics? [Writing]

Step 2: Take the tests

Step 3: Get credit

- Talk to your school counselor to arrange to add the credits to your high school transcript.

If I am not satisfied with my results, can I retest? If so, how soon?
